After leaving public office in 1998, Mr. Albanese practiced law, and became Marketing Director at INVESCO and then Managing Director of Institutional Sales & Marketing at Mesirow Financial. Mr. Albanese remains active in civic affairs; among other pursuits, he is working with both Democrats and Republicans to promote non-partisan elections in New York City.

Mr. Albanese's practice is broad-based, providing advice and counseling to a wide array of businesses and industries, with a particular focus on financial services. He holds FINRA Series 7 and 63 securities licenses.

Mr. Albanese has taught on an adjunct basis at the John Jay College of Justice and at St. Joseph's College, and has served on the boards of a number of non-profit groups, including Xaverian High School and the McKinley Youth and Adult Community Center. He speaks Italian.
